



Family Volunteer Request

In order to provide the best educational environment possible to our students, Resilience Charter School requests that families volunteer at least 15 hours per year for each student enrolled in the school. Volunteer hours may be completed by any family member or friend on behalf of the student. Multiple volunteer opportunities will be provided, including tasks that can be completed from home or at the school.

There are many advantages for students attending a small school, including personalized attention to student needs and a family-like atmosphere. The limited staff size means that volunteer support is needed to allow teachers and administrators to spend the majority of their time investing in student education.

Families can provide critical support in the areas of facilities upkeep, fundraising, event planning, set-up and clean-up, clerical assistance, development of programs such as mentoring, tutoring, expert community networks, anti-bullying awareness, cultural awareness, decorating, subbing for teachers and support staff, making or buying food for events & fundraisers, developing student, staff and volunteer recognition programs, and more.

Volunteers must log their hours with the Front Desk as they are completed in order for accurate tracking. Students may contribute to volunteer hours on their families' behalf. Showing up to an event or volunteer opportunity is not sufficient; completion of quality volunteer work is required to log hours.

Student enrollment is not contingent upon fulfillment of annual family volunteer hours. We simply ask for family involvement to ensure a high-quality learning environment for all our Resilience community members.
