



# HOW TO JOIN A ZOOM CLASS



# Step 1: Download Zoom to Your Computer






When it is downloaded, you will see this icon on your device:



If you click on the icon, you will come to this screen:




# You can join a meeting (or class) by clicking on the “Join” button




# You will be asked for the meeting I.D. & Password

The **meeting ID & password** can be found in each teacher's canvas class. Students should see the link when they first click on the class.




The **meeting ID & password** can be found on the **FIRST** screen or page students see after clicking on a teacher's class Page. This is their **HOME PAGE**
